The following are suggested course plans if you would like to complete the Associate in Arts and transfer to a four-year school for a variety of majors related to Public Safety. These plans are based on the program requirements of the 2023-2024 catalog. These are only recommendations — you may take courses in another order upon consultation with your advisor. These plans are based on you starting with college-level math and English courses, starting your program in the fall, and attending full-time.
